hats have been ordered, prices have increased and as such we will need to increase our prices.

Swim Caps – Rubber Cost \$1.50 currently sell for \$2, Lycra Cost \$4.40 currently sell for \$6; Hats Cost \$4.70 currently sell for \$6; Home Folders Cost \$5.90 currently sell for \$9 – increase to \$10. Maryanne proposed a new chair bag which has Velcro tabs to allow it to fit junior and senior chairs – cost \$5.45 sell for \$10. P & C approved new chair bags.
